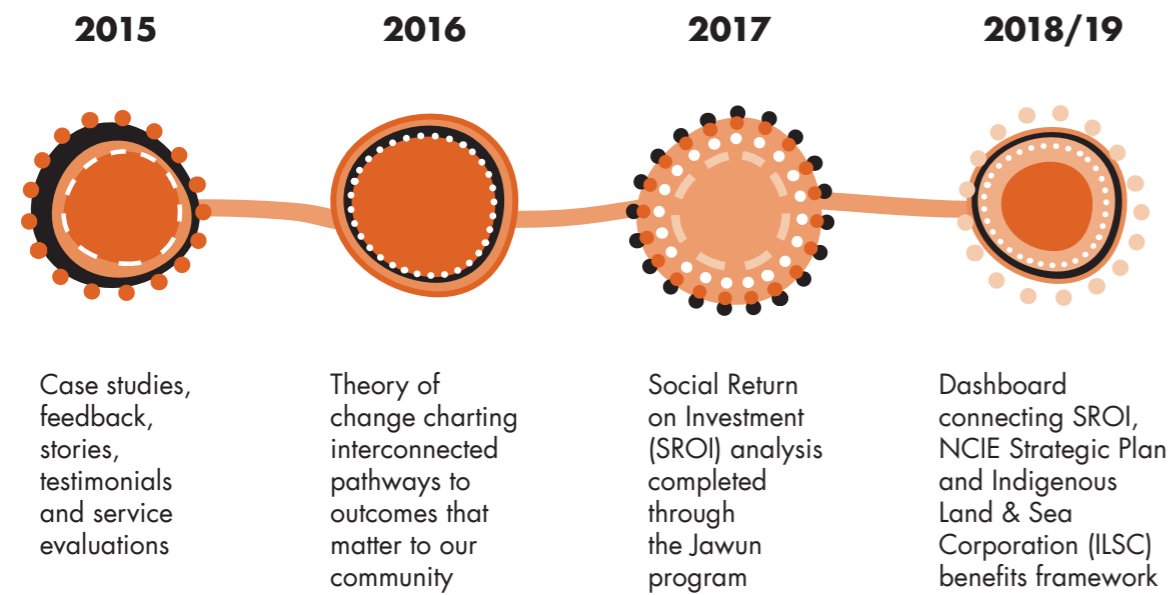

NCIE'S IMPACT MEASUREMENT JOURNEY

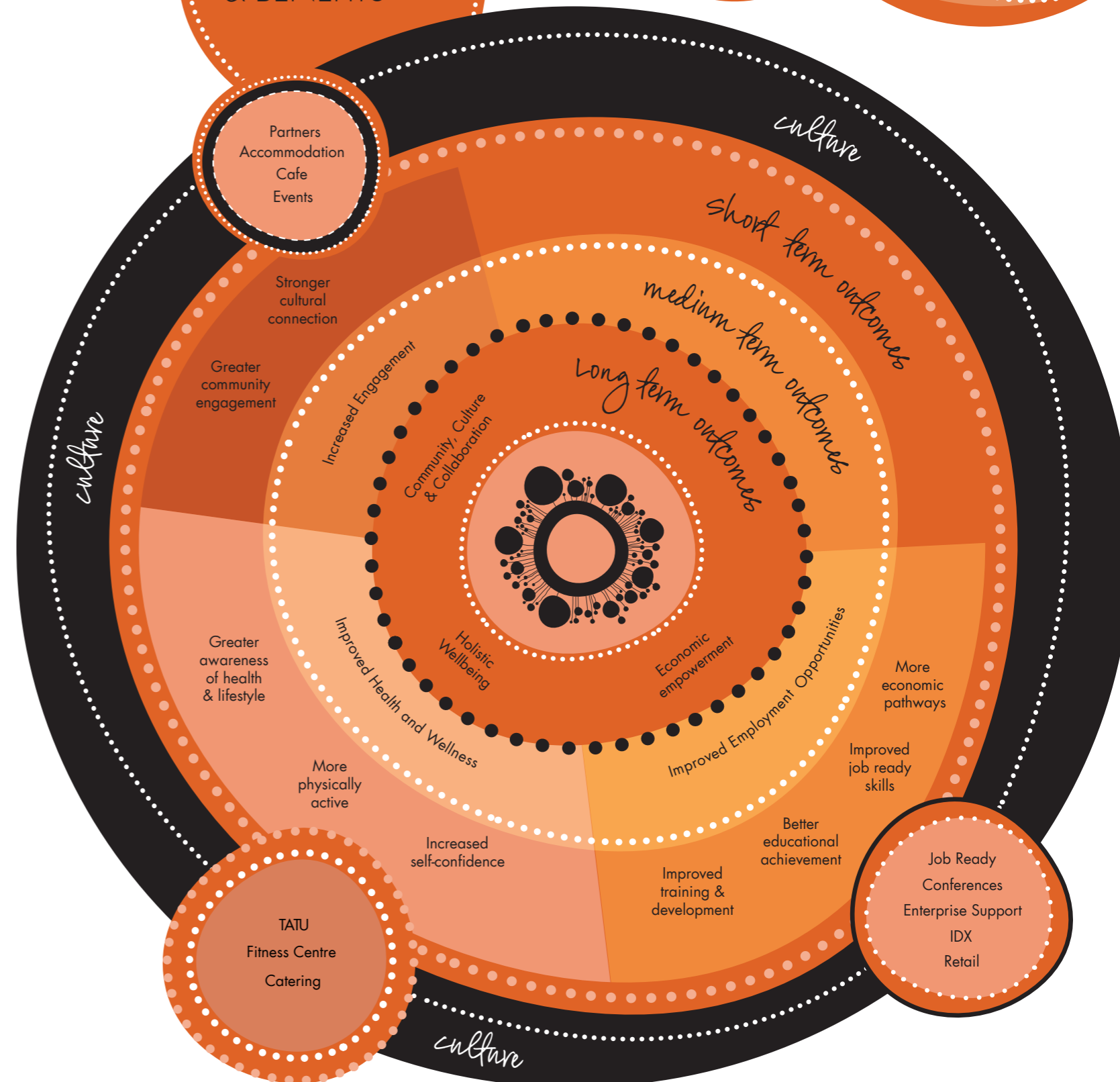


NCIE is committed to continually improving how we deliver long-term improvements to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander wellbeing.

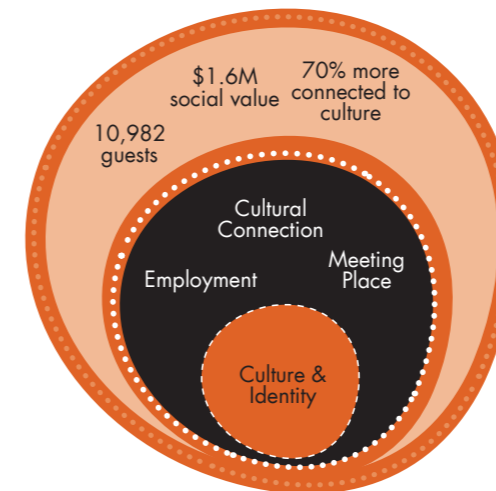
NCIE is a member and registered supplier with Supply Nation and accredited with Social Traders.

NCIE Hospitality's accommodation, conference and catering services are highly sought after due to their unique offerings. Guests experience Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples' cultures through our people, catering, cultural ceremonies, art and craft, community and fitness members, and other NGOs and businesses on site. Hospitality clients comprised corporate & private (62%), government (23%), and community (15%).

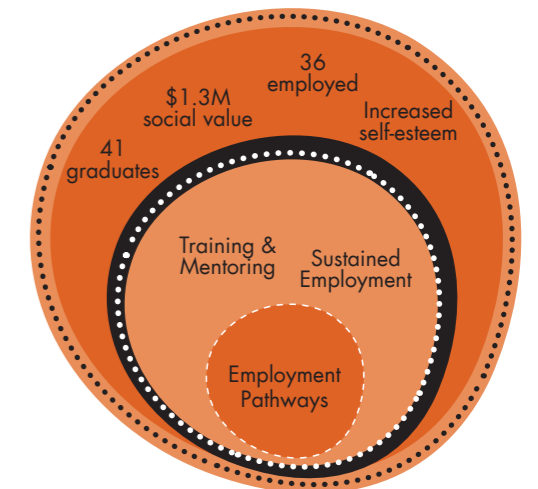

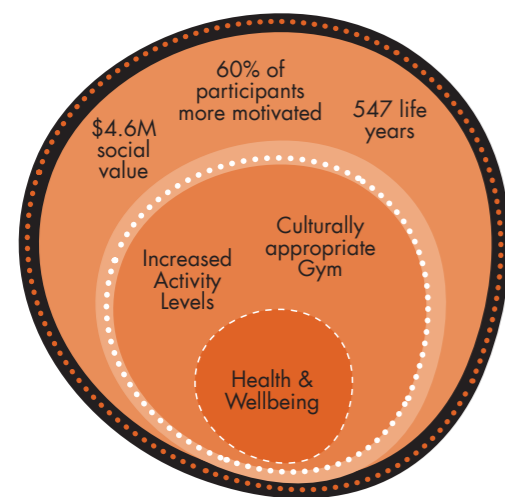

FITNESS & AQUATICS



NCIE Fitness & Aquatic Centre supports healthy lifestyles for 2001 members. It offers a wide range of fitness and wellbeing services and is a culturally safe place for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. Group fitness programs are specifically designed to be culturally appropriate to Indigenous groups. 24% Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander members.

TALKING ABOUT TOBACCO USE: TATU



Talking About Tobacco Use is a smoking awareness and education program for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. TATU has extensive community reach through workshops, sponsorship of events, and media campaigns. Programs like TATU working in schools can reduce smoking take-up rates by an average of 12 per cent.

INDIGENOUS DIGITAL EXCELLENCE: IDX



Indigenous Digital Excellence is an innovative digital skills development program that works with Elders and young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people from communities across Australia. IDX covers a wide range of digital skills, from basic computer literacy through to piloting drones. Workshops result in increased educational motivation and digital literacy.
