

# AQUATICS CODE OF CONDUCT

## **YOU ARE YOUR CHILD'S LIFEGUARD**

- Lifeguards are here to keep everyone safe, they do not replace parental supervision.
- Unsupervised children will be removed by lifeguards.

## **ACTIVELY SUPERVISE**

- Children 5 years and under must at all times be within arm's reach of a responsible adult 16 years or over
- Siblings less than 16 years are not considered adequate supervisors for young children.
- Children 5 years and under must at all times wear a wrist band. Collect these at the front counter.

## **YOUR SAFETY IS OUR FIRST PRIORITY**

- If you fail to follow the directions of a lifeguard, you will be required to leave the pool immediately and refused entry in future.

## **KEEP THE POOL A CLEAN AND SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR EVERYONE**

- Swim safely. Avoid bombing, dunking, excessive splashing and other dangerous behaviours.
- Spitting, nose blowing, or any other discharge of bodily fluid in the pool is strictly prohibited.
- Children 2 years and under must at all times wear a swim nappy.
- Always walk when on pool deck.

## **RESPECT YOUR POOL AND ITS EQUIPMENT**

- Bin your rubbish.
- When you borrow equipment, treat it carefully, and always return it to the storeroom.
- Avoid sitting or hanging on the lane ropes.
- When swimming laps, keep to the left hand side of the lane, and swim to the lane speed. Do not swim laps in the Free Swim lane.

## **RESPECT OTHERS**

- Discriminatory, abusive, offensive or disruptive behaviour towards other patrons or staff will not be tolerated. You will be asked to leave immediately, and refused entry in future.

## **KEEP IT POSITIVE**

- Whenever giving your child feedback on their swimming lesson, keep it constructive and encouraging.

## **LEAVE INSTRUCTING TO THE INSTRUCTORS**
